The first quarter of 2018 has been the strongest quarter ever for EV sales. Automakers sold more than 54,000 EVs, a 32 percent increase from the first quarter of 2017.

With sales exceeding 25,500, March 2018 has become the strongest month ever for EV sales. The fact that record sales occurred in the first quarter, a period where they have typically lagged, is even more extraordinary and bodes well for the entire year. 

EV Public and Workplace Charging Points Continue Upward Trend

Just as EV sales are growing at an increasing rate, so too are EV charging stations expanding across the country. In 2016, the number of charging points increased by 18 percent. By the end of 2017, more than 47,000 public and workplace charging points were available for use in the U.S. (Read more).
